Masquerade

(Choir families are asked to be responsible for \$550 per child for this choir)

Masquerade is open to all students by audition only. Masquerade involves an advanced level of singing and dancing and typically competes in four competitions, in addition to performing in every show put on by UCB. This group may also be competing at a nationals competition which requires additional rehearsals, dedication and finances. This group will learn singing and breathing techniques, music theory, solfege, and intermediate/advanced dance techniques. Masquerade rehearsals are after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Additional rehearsals may be scheduled.

Spellbound

(Choir families are asked to be responsible for \$550 per child for this choir)

Spellbound is open to any student that sings Soprano or Alto by audition only. Spellbound involves an advanced level of singing and dancing and typically competes in four competitions, in addition to performing in every show put on by UCB. This group may also be competing at a nationals competition which requires additional rehearsals, and finances. This group will learn singing and breathing techniques, music theory, solfege, and intermediate/advanced dance techniques. Spellbound rehearsals are after school on Mondays. Additional rehearsals may be scheduled.
